
VISION 2019

- They were God's holy portion dedicated to ritual service and sacred duties.







LEADERSHIP SHORTAGES

- Church rises and falls on leadership

- Challenge is to multiply leaders at a rate that keeps pace with growth





COMMUNICATION



- Leadership calling requires that you GROW your communication skills:
 - Speaking, writing
 - acquiring skills outside of your comfort zone.
- leverage every channel to get that message to the right people
- Commit to continuous growth in communication skills.
 - Teaching & Preaching
 - Writing & blogging
 - Social media etc...

CHARACTER

Focus on developing the type of character that upgrades our relational skills.



- If our character is growing, everything else needed for effective leadership will grow accordingly.
- If certain leadership essentials are lagging behind, character growth usually makes up for whatever else is missing.
- Principle "Walk in a manner worthy of your calling."
 - With all humility and gentleness,
 - Patience
 - Bearing with one another in love
 - Eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (Eph 4:1-3)





How is character developed?



- Leadership gifts are deposited in an instant, but Godly character is developed over a lifetime.
- GOD tests your heart to form your character:
 - PAUL: Trials & Tests → Steadfastness → Perfect / Complete
 - JAMES: Suffering → Endurance → Character
 - Like purifying gold & silver in the fire (Prov. 17:3)
- Do not focus on ministry accomplishments, communication skills, size of churches.

1. How to Think Like a Leader



- What is leadership?
 - Leadership is serving
- Therefore to THINK like a leader means to think like a servant
- IF the desire to lead doesn't spring forth from a heart to serve, then we've completely missed the point of true leadership

1. How to Think Like a Leader



- “Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory” (Mark 10:37)
- In the worldly way of thinking, leadership was:
 1. Position (Grant us to sit on your right & left)
 2. Glory (in your glory)
 3. Authority (seats of authority next to Jesus)

1. How to Think Like a Leader



- JESUS corrected the disciples wrong thinking about leadership & authority:
- “The rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them... But it shall not be so among you. Whoever would be the greatest among you **MUST** be your **SERVANT** & whoever would be the first among you must be the **SLAVE** of all.
- For the son of man came not to be served but to serve & give his life as a ransom for many.” (Mark 10:42-45)





Available

Some people are extremely faithful but never rise to the next level of leadership because they are way too busy to be available for God

No matter how much potential a person has, if that person is too busy to be used by God, then we cannot help him/her maximise their leadership potential.

Isaiah 6:8 - Here I am - send me.

Involved

We prefer home grown leaders BUT NOT LAZY ones.

We are only interested in people who are available and involved at some level in what they are already doing.

We are NOT interested in those who church hop, half committed to their local church & who do nothing while waiting for a personal invitation to minister or lead.

They might be available but they're NOT involved.

KEY: WE LOOK FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE ALREADY INVOLVED WITHIN THE CHURCH.

Teachable

Teachable people are humble & willing to learn, grow & receive correction

People who aren't willing apparently already know more than their leaders & have already maximised their leadership potential. They can move on and start something they can lead somewhere else.

TEST for teachability is to CORRECT them.

If s/he loves correction - then you've identified a potential leader worthy of your time.
If s/he hates correction - then you should look for someone else to develop.

2 Tim 3:16 - All Scripture is God breathed... profitable for teaching, reproof, correction an training in righteousness."

"Whoever hates correction is stupid" Prov. 12:1 No one has time to invest in stupid leaders.

Hungry

Humble people are hungry to grow & learn.

Teachability & hunger are ROOTED IN HUMILITY.

They are teachable and willing to embrace correction.

Look for someone who is hungry for more knowledge, training, and responsibility.

Main hunger for the WORD OF GOD.


- **INTELLECTUAL TRAINING:**
 - Teachable & Hungry - ready to **MAKE LEARNING A LIFESTYLE.**
 - Instruction is **NOT** only a transfer of knowledge but teaching people **HOW TO LEARN AND HOW TO THINK.**
 - **INSTRUCTION** Is training the **MIND OF A LEADER.**
 - We need **CONSISTENT & DISCIPLINED INTELLECTUAL TRAINING.**

2. Instruction



- We like the adventure of IMPARTATION - building close relationships that lead to personal growth. And we like the excitement of INTERNSHIP - learning new skills through on the job training with experienced leaders.
- But we DON'T like the MENTAL LABOUR OF INSTRUCTION - committing ourselves to disciplined study, opening ourselves to new ideas and applying our minds to questions that don't have easy answers and immediate applications.



 - Values

3. IMPARTATION

- Instruction focuses on informing the mind, Impartation focuses on TRANSFORMING THE HEART.
- The typical setting for IMPARTATION IS EVERYWHERE REAL LIFE HAPPENS.
- Strong overlap between discipleship & impartation.
 - Discipleship helps someone become a better Christian
 - Impartation aims to help the disciple become a better leader.



 - Most generous people are generous not because their heads have been informed but their hearts have been transformed.
- **Trust**
 - Cultures of trust are the best environments to develop strong leaders.
 - We must be willing to TRAIN and then TRUST them & get out of their way.
- **Honour**
 - How leaders handle honour either builds or destroys a leadership multiplying culture.
 - Honour is never to be sought & always to be deflected.
- **Compassion** - care, sensitive to hopes, fears, dreams & needs.
- **Wisdom** – is gained by walking with the wise


